## FAITH & THE CHURCH

### Traditional belief reframed as "oppression"

*End policies that oppress intimate life, including "patriarchal restrictions on abortion, childbirth and childraising, gender expression and transition, marriage, and divorce."*

► **On your ballot: HJ1 writes abortion into the constitution; HJ9 gives courts leverage in every religious-freedom case.**

## FREEDOM

### Public safety, borders & private property

*Redirect police funding "as steps towards fully abolishing the police and prison system." "End ICE detention and deportations... grant amnesty for all immigrants regardless of status... end visa caps and quotas."*

► **On your ballot: HJ2 restores felon voting before a full sentence — the platform demands it even for the currently incarcerated.**

## COUNTRY & CONSTITUTION

### A stated goal to replace the system

*"We are workers fighting to transform society: to win the battle for democracy, draft a new constitution, and create a democratic socialist republic" — and to "abolish the Senate" and "replace the President and Supreme Court with an executive and judiciary... subordinate to Congress."*

► **On your ballot: HJ1, HJ9 & HJ2 permanently rewrite Virginia's constitution — on party-line votes, beyond future repeal.**
